For over 11 years Great Expectations Academy has seen a tremendous growth and continue to strive in providing a quality education to our children. The school was founded in 1999, with the first classes being held in the activities hall of the Cornerstone Baptist Church. In January 2000, children returned from Christmas break to a newly developed site in the present location on Camino Antigua. The site consisted of 4 used classroom buildings, a restroom building, a small office and a dirt playground. With the dedication of parents, students and staff we have continued to improve our campus by adding.....

2001: an administration building; a library with computer lab; a multi-purpose building for music/art classes. Sixth grade classes became available.

2002: a Middle School building for the newly added 7th and 8th grade classes; a restroom building; a basketball court.

2003: new quad buildings, designed by the administration, which replaced the used classroom buildings.

2004: donated playground equipment for the younger grades; a sandbox

2005: a concrete 4-square slab; additional shade structures over the lunch/ramada area

2006: a new fine arts/music building; new playground structure for the younger grades; an obstacle course structure for the large playground; a "Secret Garden" for creative thinking; misters for the lunch/ramada area.

2007: full day Kindergarten; shade structure for the obstacle course

2008: new paint and carpet in the library; graphics for the school bus; two new tables in the lunch/ramada area; grass in the upper playground.

2009: a new building for band/classrooms; additional concrete in the ramada/lunch area; security fencing around campus; 3 new tables in ramada and benches around campus; new shade canopy in lower playground; acquisition of land north of campus.
